AAEJATC Covid-19 Technical Instruction Standards

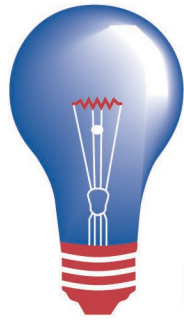
The AAEJATC is committed to adhering to all CDC and government requirements to provide a safe learning environment for all the apprentices, instructors, staff, and guests while onsite at the JATC. This is something the JATC takes seriously, and with your help in exercising these precautionary measures, it will mitigate the risk of having the JATC be a hotspot for an outbreak, and if an incident does occur, reduce the effect it may have on the overall operation of the JATC. The following are requirements charged with every person associated with the JATC:

- **Everyone must personally check their temperature before entering the AAEJATC**
- **Keep at least 6' between everyone, including during labs and breaks**
- **Facial coverings are required unless there is a physician written exemption**
- **Wash your hands regularly, especially after touching surfaces**
- **Use sanitizer regularly, especially after touching surfaces**
- **Practice good hygiene**
- **If you are at a desk or workstation, the area and/or equipment must be cleaned with provided cleaner after the class is over**

Like all of you, the AAEJATC wants things to get back to normal as soon as possible. By all of us doing our part, we can get there. If the precautionary measures stated above are observed not being adhered to while at the JATC, corrective action will be taking to ensure the operational environment at the JATC remains as safe as possible.
